Dave Dooling is an experienced space writer who has worked on a range of missions since Apollo. As science editor of The Huntsville [Alabama] Times (1977-85) he covered Space Shuttle development and early missions, including the first three Spacelab missions. He has worked inside payload control on Shuttle science missions, and has made a two-hour underwater space walk simulation. Since 2002 he has been the education officer at the National Solar Observatory. He is co-author of *Space Travel: A History, Engineering Tomorrow, Science On Orbit, Huntsville: A Pictorial History*, and *The Christmas Planet*. He holds an MS in Space Studies from the University of North Dakota, and has received the National Space Club's Press Award and Goddard History Essay Award.
